The Awards

Participants in the Young Artists Competition compete for three awards:

-FIRST PLACE-

Dorothy Allen Turner Award - \$1,500

1st place winner appears with the LaGrange Symphony Orchestra in Callaway Auditorium during its 2018/19 concert season.

-SECOND PLACE-

Max Kaplan Award - \$1,000

-THIRD PLACE-

NOTE Award - \$500

Eligibility

Contestant must be under the age of 26 on February 3, 2018 and must be a resident or resident student of Georgia, Alabama, Florida, North Carolina, South Carolina or Tennessee.

Application Deadline: December 28, 2017 (*for receipt of all materials*)

Future Competitions: 2019 for Winds, 2020 for Strings

Repertoire Requirements

Note: Audition repertoire must be a work composed for soloist and orchestra, as first-place winners will be invited to perform with the **LaGrange Symphony Orchestra**. Winner will play this piece or another selection mutually agreed upon by the winner and the LSO Music Director.

One movement from a concerto or work composed for soloist and orchestral work

- ◆ Repertoire must be memorized
- ◆ Contestants should bring, for the judges' use, one score of the selection performed
- ◆ Contestants are encouraged to bring their own accompanist; however, an accompanist can be provided for a \$60.00 fee
- ◆ Performance time should not exceed 15 minutes
- ◆ Warm-up facilities are available
