Finalists will be expected to perform live for the competition judges on the morning of February 6, 2021. If it is deemed unsafe to hold a live performance on that date due to COVID, finalist will be given the choice to resubmit the same piece again or have original submission judged for final decision.

The Awards

Participants in the Young Artists Competition compete for three awards:

-FIRST PLACE-

Dorothy Allen Turner Award - \$1,500

1st place winner appears with the LaGrange Symphony Orchestra, with this piece, in Callaway Auditorium, at a future date.

-SECOND PLACE-

Max Kaplan Award - \$1,000

-THIRD PLACE-

NOTE Award - \$500

Eligibility

Contestant must be under the age of 26 on February 6, 2021 and must be a resident or resident student of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina or Tennessee.

Application Deadline: December 11, 2020 **(for receipt of all materials)**

Future Competitions: 2022 for Winds, 2023 for Strings

Repertoire Requirements

Note: Audition repertoire must be a work composed for soloist and orchestra, as first-place winners will perform with the **LaGrange Symphony Orchestra**.

One movement from a concerto or work composed for soloist and orchestral work

- Repertoire must be memorized.
- Contestants should bring, for the judges' use, one score of the selection performed.
- Contestants are encouraged to bring their own accompanist; however, an accompanist can be provided for a fee.
- Performance time should not exceed 20 minutes.
- Warm-up facilities are available.
