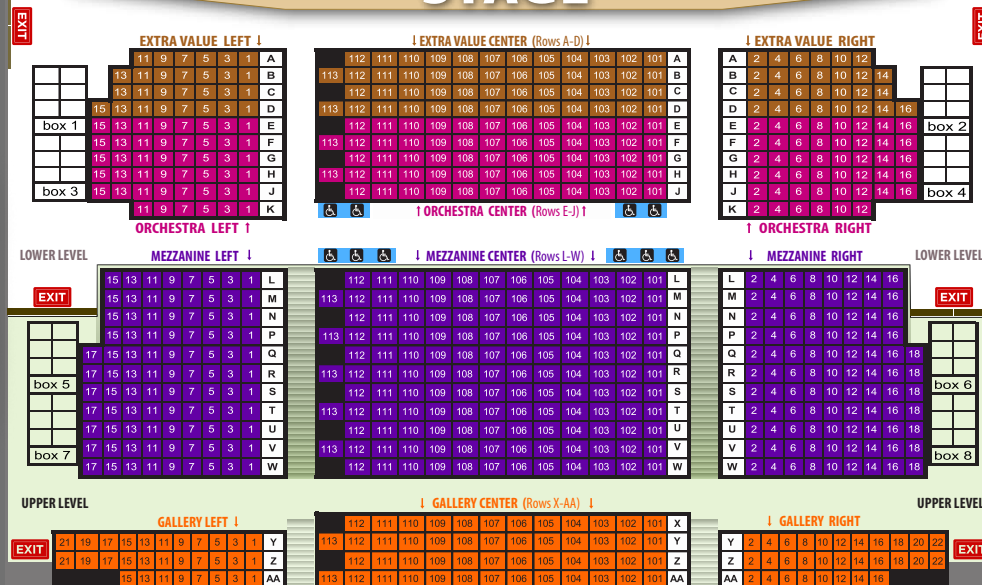


DECEMBER 8, 2026

The concert concludes with music from some of our most beloved heroes and adventures, including themes from **Superman, Batman, The Avengers**, and **Apollo 13**.

We conclude our 2026/27 season with **MUSICAL REVOLUTIONARIES**, a fitting finale honoring composers whose bold artistic visions changed the course of music. **Beethoven's** dramatic **Prometheus Overture** and monumental **Triple Concerto**, featuring acclaimed violinist **Emily Daggett Smith**, cellist **Zuill Bailey**, and pianist **William Ransom**, lead to **Shostakovich's** powerful **Symphony No. 5 in D minor**—one of the most compelling orchestral statements of the twentieth century. Together, these works remind us that great music does more than reflect its time; it helps shape what comes next.
